### **Dumpster Day**

Due to recent budget problems, the city had put it up for re-use (our community center is also up for re-use). Proposal on table that would require a \$70,000/year budget to keep the center open ½ time. Looking for possible corporate sponsorships – Andy will investigate who to contact within Google to

see if there is a fit there.

**Restaurant Fundraiser**

Possible candidates are Red Robin, Fresh Choice, Chevy's, Panda Express, Mimi's. Barbara will contact Red Robin and Chevy's to set something up for right after our Dumpster Day, possibly a second one after the quarterly meeting.
